



GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

This policy document is produced in accordance with the responsibilities of the Company under Section 2(3) of the Health and Safety at Work Etc Act 1974 and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999.

In accepting the responsibility, the Company will as far as reasonably practicable: -

- Provide such instruction and training as is necessary to promote appropriate standards of Health and Safety.
- Provide and maintain plant and systems of work that are safe and without risk to health.
- Encourage safety and absence of risks to health in connection with the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances.
- Maintain its premises in a condition that is safe and without risk to health, whilst providing and maintaining means of access to and exit from its premises that are safe and without risk to health.
- Provide and maintain working environment facilities and arrangements that are without risk to the health, safety, and welfare of its employees.
- Undertake routine internal and external audits of operating procedures.
- Investigate all serious accidents as defined in the Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 2013 (RIDDOR) to any person as soon as possible, and always within twenty-four hours of notification and all other accidents/incidents within seven days were considered appropriate.
- To carry out Risk Assessments of all work tasks required by the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999.
- To ensure that the Company makes adequate financial provision to address issues relevant to Health and Safety.
- To monitor the effectiveness of this System.
